


# Andrés Orozco-Estrada conducts the Frankfurt Radio Symphony

## Andrés Orozco-Estrada (Music Director, Conductor)

Music director of the hr-Sinfonieorchester since 2014, Andrés Orozco-Estrada has since 2014 also served as music director of the Houston Symphony. Additionally, he became principal guest conductor of the London Philharmonic Orchestra in 2015.

Orozco-Estrada was born in Colombia in 1977 and studied in Vienna. One of the most popular conductors of his generation, he regularly appears with such world-renowned orchestras as the Vienna Philharmonic, Mahler Chamber Orchestra, Dresden Staatskapelle, Orchestre National de France, Orchestra of the National Academy of Santa Cecilia, Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra, Chicago Symphony, Pittsburgh Symphony, Cleveland Orchestra, and Philadelphia Orchestra.

## Seong-Jin Cho (Piano)

Seong-Jin Cho was brought to the world's attention in Fall 2015 when he won the coveted Gold Medal at the Chopin International Competition in Warsaw. They rushed to release a recording of Cho's live competition highlights, following on the success of the debut CD, Seong-Jin signed an exclusive contract with Deutsche Grammophon.

He collaborates with conductors at the highest level such as Myung-Whun Chung, Valery Gergiev, Mikhail Pletnev, Vladimir Ashkenazy. In 2017, he performed for the first time at Carnegie Hall's Keyboard Virtuosos series.

## hr-Sinfonieorchester

Established in 1929, the hr-Sinfonieorchester was one of Germany's first radio symphony orchestras. The orchestra has an established reputation for the high quality of its winds section and the rich timbres of its strings, as well as for its dynamic performance style. The world-renowned orchestra performs a wide range of musical styles. Recognized for its innovative CD recordings, which have set a new standard for Romantic and late Romantic works, it is regarded as one of the world's leading interpreters of Mahler and Bruckner. This musical tradition, which started with Eliahu Inbal, has been inherited and carried on through Paavo Jarvi, the orchestra's current Conductor Laureate, and by its current Music Director, Andrés Orozco-Estrada.
